

How to make a Palm Cross



STEP 1

Turn the palm cross over and fold the extra length diagonally down to the right, like a sash.



STEP 2

Turn your palm cross over. This is what your palm cross will look like from the back.



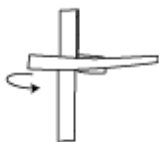
STEP 3

Turn the palm cross over and fold the extra length diagonally down to the right, like a sash.



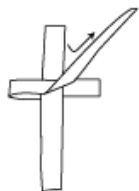
STEP 4

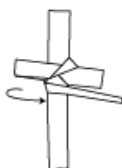
STEP 7A

Turn the palm cross over and fold the extra length diagonally down to the right, like a sash.



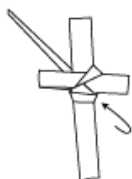
STEP 7B

Turn your palm cross over. This is what your palm cross will look like from the back.



STEP 8

Run the extra length straight across, left to right, right under the "arms."



STEP 9

Wrap the extra length behind the cross, diagonally up and to the left.



STEP 10

Tuck any extra length into the loops on the back of the cross (the side facing you) to secure your cross.



STEP 11

Make any adjustments as needed. Then carefully crease the folds so your cross looks nice and tidy.
